

## **EQUINE GENERAL CARE**

- 1. Farrier/Blacksmith every 6-8 weeks.
- 2. Vaccinations once a year.
  - Encephalitis (Eastern and Western)
  - Rabies
  - Tetanus
  - West Nile Virus (given every 6 months)
  - Flu/Rhino
  - Strangles
- 3. De-sand your horse once a month for 7 days using a psyllium based product:
  - Sand Clear
  - Sandblast
  - Equi-Aid
- 4. De-worm your horse on a regular schedule.
  - Frequency is generally determined by fecal egg count.
- 5. Senior diet recommended for older horses. Feed according to work level.
  - Good quality feed always recommended.
  - Good quality hay.
- 6. Feed Storage should have a minimum of 2 barriers (locks):
  - Door to feed room that is locked.
  - Locked bin INSIDE feed room.
- 7. Horse Teeth:
  - Oral exam at least once a year.
  - Floating as recommended by your veterinarian.
- **8.** Pasture Management:
  - Barbed wire is <u>NOT</u> recommended for horses.
  - Pick up manure.
  - Fertilize, seed, and irrigate pastures if needed.
  - Your local Ag Extension office can help.
