Just take this scenario for instance: Let's assume the cattle market is up at this point in time. A rancher in central Texas runs a commercial herd of beef cattle. Three heifers that the rancher was going to keep for replacements are found dead. The rancher calls the vet to come out to the ranch to perform an autopsy. The vet diagnoses blackleg in all three heifers. Because they weren't vaccinated, the rancher just lost about \$15,000-\$18,000...maybe more. Those heifers would have made the rancher, give or take, about \$1500 a year for about 10-12 years. Now those heifers *and* part of that annual profit are gone, all because the rancher declined to spend the \$18.00-24.00/head per year it would have taken to prevent this catastrophe. A good rule of thumb for people in the cattle business (and any other people for that matter): Things that *can* be prevented *should* be prevented.
